

Welcome from the Chair

Welcome to the 11th Haskell Symposium! The main focus of the Symposium is to present original research on Haskell, discuss practical experience and future development of the language, and to promote other forms of denotative programming. The Symposium is on 27–28 September 2018, in St Louis, Missouri, USA, co-located with ICFP 2018.

There was a wide range of submissions, 28 in total, covering a diverse spectrum of topics. As in previous years the submission process used two deadlines: an early and a regular one. Submissions rejected from the early deadline could be resubmitted to the regular one, after addressing concerns raised by the reviewers. Each submission received at least 3 reviews. We held two virtual review meetings, one for each deadline, and accepted 13 papers of which 2 are functional pearls. In addition to these papers, we accepted 2 experience reports, and 1 system demonstration.

On behalf of the Program Committee, I would like to thank all the authors for submitting their papers to the Haskell Symposium. I am also particularly grateful to the members of the program committee and sub-reviewers for all their time, hard work, and vigorous discussion. Thanks also to the Haskell Symposium Steering Committee, as well as the ICFP organizers.
